Overland Park Advocacy

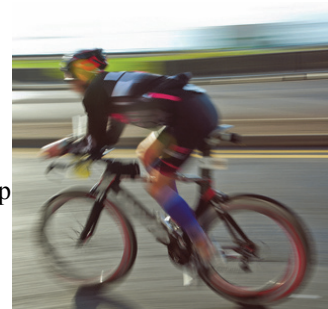
